

PITT MEADOWS REGIONAL AIRPORT AIRSIDE PHOTO IDENTIFICATION CARDS

As part of our preparation for the 2010 Olympics and our ongoing long term quest to improve security on the airport, effective January 28, 2010, all individuals who wish to be airside and unescorted must have a PMRA issued identification card.

Identification cards can be obtained in the SecFor/RCMP office in the east end of the grey "butler building", located in the parking lot across from the Terminal Building. SecFor staff will be available to create your identification card from 10am until 3pm, 7 days a week from Sunday, January 10 until Wednesday, January 27th. After that date, an appointment will have to be made to generate your identification card. Contact Ashley in the Airport Administration Office (604-465-8977) to set up an appointment with security officials. You will be asked for photo ID (a drivers license), basic contact information (phone number) and the location of your property/interest on the field (ie. C-GANG at Flightline or AME at Sierra Helicopters).

PMRA airside identification cards will be valid for a period of one year and will serve to significantly enhance security on our airport.

Please Note:

Airside Photo Identification Card requirements do not apply to employees who will never need to be airside unescorted, guests who you may be escorting, or Flight School students who have their own identification cards.

Couriers and contractors who are airside can expect to be asked by Security Staff for their company identification and specifics as to their contact/business airside.
